

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

Parents, spectators and fans are to conduct themselves in a manner that "Honors the Game" and demonstrates respect to other players, coaches, officials, parents, spectators, and fans. In becoming a member of the lacrosse community, parents assume certain obligations and responsibilities to the game of lacrosse and its participants. Parents who conduct themselves with HONESTY and INTEGRITY will bring credit to the sport of lacrosse, themselves, their players, and their organization. It is only through such conduct that our sport can continue to earn and maintain a positive image. Each Elkhorn Lacrosse Parent must adhere to the following "Code of Conduct" elements:

- Sportsmanship and fair play are essential to the game and must be taught at all levels and developed both at home and on the field during practices and games.
- The safety and welfare of the players are of primary importance.
- Parents, spectators and fans are expected to demonstrate the utmost respect for officials and reinforce that respect in his/her players.
- Parents are to value good sportsmanship and fair play over the value of winning.
- Grievances or misunderstandings between coaches, officials or any other parties involved with the sport should be communicated through the proper channels and procedures, never on or about the field of play in view of spectators or participants.
- Parents, spectators and fans must never openly or maliciously criticize, harass, or threaten an official, coach, player or opponent.
- Parents should always demonstrate positive behaviors and respect towards all involved. (i.e. Coaches/Officials/Parents/Players/Scorekeepers/Trainers)
- Parents are expected to keep their player(s) US Lacrosse Membership(s) valid at all times.

Any violations of this code of conduct will be reviewed by the Elkhorn Lacrosse Club board and may result in suspension from playing, coaching or spectating. 3 Violations within one season will result in expulsion from the club.
